CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1.** TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE: The Tournament Committee shall be the Match Committee of the Commonwealth Golf Club.
- 2.** ENTRIES: Opens to all players that have a current Golf Australia handicap. All entries shall be accompanied by the players handicap, home club, golf link number and the \$100 entry fee. Entries close on Friday 5th February 2010 at 5.00pm or when the field reaches capacity. Please forward entries to the details listed above
- 3.** RULES: The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews, Scotland, together with such local rules as are in force. If any dispute arises on any point, the decision made by the Tournament Committee shall be final.
- 4.** TROPHIES: Separate trophies for AM & PM
Trophies for men and women will be determined by field size
- 5.** TIES: All ties shall be decided by countback.
- 6.** PROTESTS: Protests must be made to the Tournament Committee not later than ten (10) minutes after the conclusion of each round.
- 7.** Field is limited to a maximum of 112 players, both AM & PM. In the event that entries exceed the maximum field size a balloted draw will occur in deciding participants in the field.
- 8.** DRAW AND STARTING TIMES: The draw will be completed by the Tournament Committee and forwarded to all entrants.
- 9.** HONORARY MEMBERS: Competitors will be made Honorary Members of the Commonwealth Golf Club for the day of the event.
- 10.** PRACTICE: Practice rounds will ***not*** be permitted.
- 11.** CADDIES: Professional golfers shall not be permitted to act as caddies.
- 12.** DRESS: Denim clothing, cargo shorts/pants, collarless tops and shirts with large advertising monograms are strictly prohibited on the course and in the clubhouse for players and caddies. Trousers or tailored shorts with predominantly white socks above the ankle, collared shirts, and golf shoes are required AS STANDARD FOR PLAY.
