We are offering these clubs an opportunity to receive a free clinic for their Lady members and any lady non-members in their immediate area. The clinics will be run by Mandy Buckley and other low handicap markers in our District. South Western will provide the balls and expertise needed to run the clinics.

The aim behind this proposal is to encourage women to try golf and therefore help boost female membership at these clubs. We also aim to encourage their own female members by improving their golf. We see this as a great opportunity for women and a great way for South Western to support our affiliated clubs.
