CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. Competition shall be played in accordance with the rules of golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Club of St Andrews, Scotland subject to such local rules as are in force on the day on which the competition takes place.
2. The Match Committee shall have full control of the competition and shall have the right to alter the conditions or starting times and shall also have the right to refuse entry to any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
3. The Match Committee will settle any disputes or protests. Such disputes or protests must be lodged no later than 15 minutes after the conclusion of play.
4. In the event of a tie, a countback shall determine the winner or winners, using the system as recommended by the GA.
5. GA Handicap and Golf Link numbers will be needed on the day of play.
6. The Committee may, in the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, either shorten the contest or reschedule on another day.
