Conditions of Play – Mixed Pinehurst

1. Competitions shall be played in accordance with the rules of golf, as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Club of St. Andrews, Scotland. Subject to such local rules as are in force on the course over which the competitions take place.
2. All events are restricted to members of Affiliated SWGA Inc. clubs who hold a GA handicap.
3. The SWGA Inc. Golf Operations Committee (Min. 3) shall have full control of the competition and have the right to alter the conditions or starting times, or refuse entry to any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal. In the event of extreme weather conditions, SWGA Golf Operations Committee reserves the right to alter, suspend or cancel play.
4. The SWGA Golf Operations Committee will settle any dispute or protest. Such dispute or protest must be lodged not later than 15 minutes after conclusion of play. The Committee's decision is final.
5. Entry fee must be paid at time of entry. No entry fee will be refunded to a competitor withdrawing after the draw has been posted unless the Golf Operations Committee approves special circumstances. Substitutes may be permitted after consultation with the Tournament Secretary.
6. Winners will be decided by the GA recommended count-back system.
7. Winners may accept one major trophy only
8. Caddies: The use of professionals or trainee professional golfers as caddies is not permitted.
Penalty: Disqualification
9. **Mobile phones:** Players should refrain from using mobile phones during play as a courtesy to others the use of mobile phones may be used to contact the clubhouse in cases of emergency or for a ruling. Phones should otherwise be switched off or in silent mode.
10. **Slow Play** will not be tolerated. Pace of play will be monitored and penalties may be imposed for infringements. (Rule 6 – 7)
11. **Motorised Transportation is permitted.**
10. **Distance Measuring Devices:** For all SWGA tournaments, a player may obtain distance information by use of a distance measuring device. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect their play (e.g. Elevation changes, wind speed, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3.
11. **Dress regulations:** Players, caddies and spectators are requested to abide by the regulations in force at each host club.
12. Draw will be posted on Association Website Thursday prior to the event.
